MEETING RECORDING FILE WAS DAMAGED DURING SAVE, UNABLE TO TYPE DIRECT TRANSCRIPT.

Saindon reviewed the guest moorage and regular moorage issues, possible short term moorage fixes. So many boats that the harbor has no room for the incoming boats. Referred back to the regular commission meeting on 7/10 where the discussion about F/V Two Captains staying at the end of commercial was discussed. Some of the issues that the port is facing regarding guest/transient vessels is the rules set forth in Ordinance 15, but also requirements set by granted funds through OSMB. On transient dock OSMB is regularly monitoring transient dock and does not want commercial vessels tied up. One possible help to staff would be to address staff ability to shuffle vessels as needed. Another possible help would be to place the ability to require more recreational boats to meet the movement requirements. Discussion regarding F/V Hawk, F-8, F-16, CH-22 and CH-27 as vessels that are not making movements.

Creating requirements or addressing having no wet storage in the boat basin may help. Discussed possibly having a conversation with legal and insurance companies regarding the correct definition of wet storage.
